8. Portfolio Reports: 053/19

- (a) Cemetery and Closed Churchyard: Cemetery Charges and Conditions are to be considered at the next meeting.
- (b) Emergency Procedure: No report.
- (c) <u>Footpaths</u>: Lead Member Cllr. Alison Rowland reported the contractor has started trimming of the SWCP and LMP Public Rights of Way for 2019 and slow progress is being made with the Modification Order relating to Green Lane.
- (d) <u>Highways</u>: The Chairman reported that Cornwall Council has admitted that there have been delays in putting forward a number of client briefs and following receipt of the approvals from Parish Councils on various Highway Projects there were further delays within Cornwall Council. The Widemouth Bay Scheme will now be in place by 2020/21 however in the meantime temporary restrictions will be put in place.
- (e) <u>Planning</u>: The Chairman reported attending a Planning Conference along with Cllr. Alison Rowland and Cllr. Pamela Idelson. Cornwall Council has revamped its Planning Department dividing the county into eight area teams with each team being responsible for a particular area, Poundstock is area eight. Rather than individual case officers working across the county they will now work as a group with a planning officer as team manager, a planning staff member as team leader and six planners bringing sufficient expertise within the group to deal with most planning problems more efficiently, better coordination of services for a swifter and more informed decision. A Planning Officer from the Area Team will be attending a Parish Council Meeting by way of introduction in the future.
- (f) <u>Public Toilets</u>: The Chariman made reference to the meeting held by Cornwall Councillor Nicky Chopak with Mr. M. Beckett from Cornwall Council previously reported. An estimate for the three showers to replace the coin mechanism with micro switch, timer valve to include labour at £906.39 was discussed following which it was resolved to go ahead with the repairs, proposed cllr. Colin Gilbert seconded Cllr. Pamela Idelson, **unanimous**.

- (b) Neighbourhood Development Plan Cllr. Alison Rowland reported a busy month making positive progress. The last meeting of the Steering Group was 11 April 2019 where the main topic was the stakeholders engagement letter sent to over 96 businesses, community groups, schools etc. On 13 April 2019 a training event was held in the Gildhouse with Kathryn Statham from Cornwall Council about Local Landscape Character Assessment (LLCA) and how to complete Field Work Sheets to identify landscape character types on the map which was very well attended. The Landscape and Environment Group held its public consultation event at The Widemouth Manor on Saturday 27 April 2019 which was well supported. **Resoved** the payment of £200.00 be paid to the Widemouth Manor for catering the event, Cllr. Alison Rowland proposed Cllr. Pamela Idelson seconded, **unanimous.**
